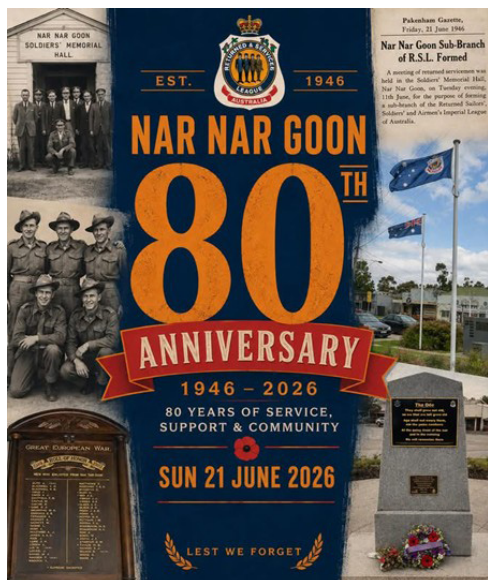

John, a very accomplished Aeronautical Instrument Engineer in the RAAF saw him developing Australia's very first flight simulators used for training pilots in the early 60's all thru until the development of one for F18 Fighters. His work took him to postings all around the world developing simulators. John also told us his intriguing tale of how he got to NNG. He also displayed a small collection of some of the interesting pieces of metal,

glass and pottery objects found in his backyard in Home Rd. He has lived an amazing 93 years. Our small group of 14 enjoyed deep conversations of more photos and newspaper clippings. We also sang a rousing chorus of Happy Birthday to Winsome. A big thank you is needed for Jan & Carmel for providing a delicious Afternoon Tea.

Our January rally was a nice relaxed rally for our first one back for the year, the children had some fun on the obstacles, jumping in the arenas and in the XC jumps.

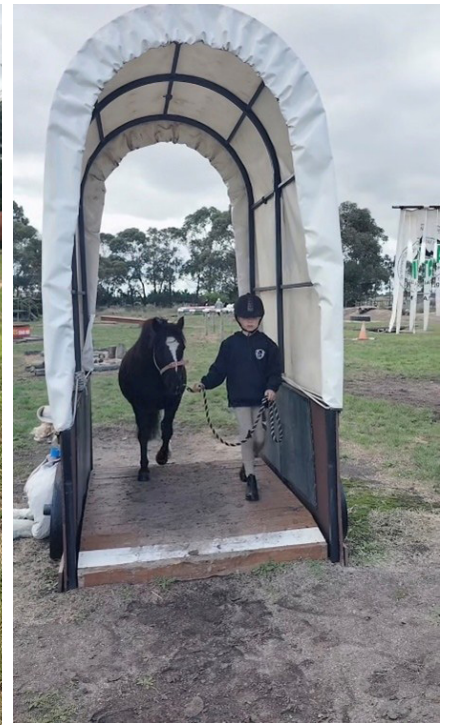
